

THE IMAGE OF MERCIFUL JESUS

Sister Faustina received the vision of Merciful Jesus on February 22, 1931 in Płock. In the evening in the cell she saw the figure of Jesus in a stance glowing. He wore a white robe, a right hand raised to bless, and the left hand touched the tilt of the robe on his chest, from where two rays came out: red and pale. There were traces of torture on his arms and legs.

Paint an image according to the pattern you see, with the signature: "Jesus, I trust in You". I desire that this image be venerated, first in your chapel, and then throughout the world. I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish I also promise victory over its enemies already here on earth, especially at the hour of death. I want this image, which you will paint with a brush, to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter; That Sunday is to be the Feast of Mercy. I desire that priests proclaim this great mercy of Mine towards souls of sinners. 47-49

I am offering people a vessel with which they are to keep coming for graces to the fountain of mercy. That vessel is this image with the signature: "Jesus, I trust in You. 327

By means of this Image I shall be granting many graces to souls; so let every soul have access to it. 570

The two rays denote Blood and Water. The pale ray stands for the Water which makes souls righteous. The red ray stands for the Blood which is the life of souls. 299
